Hazelwood Necklaces for Babies and Children

Welcome to the first web capsule about Pure Hazelwood, its story, and its products. Today's topic is necklaces for babies and children.

First of all, many parents ask us when their baby can start wearing the necklace. The answer is quite simple: **as soon as it needs to!** Pure Hazelwood necklaces are known to be an effective natural solution to help relieve teething pain as well as other small sores in infants such as: colic, regurgitation, or eczema, for example. The three main guidelines to remember are:

1. **Choose the right size:** 11 inch, or 28 cm, hazelwood necklaces are for children up to 2 years old. Make sure the necklace stays under the baby's chin so he or she won't be able to put it into his or her mouth. Parents should be able to place two fingers between the necklace and the baby's neck. 13 inch, or 33 cm, necklaces are for children between 2 and 4, and 14 inch, or 36 cm, necklaces are for children 4 to 10.
2. **Life span of the necklace:** To ensure maximum effectiveness and safety, it is important to replace the necklace every 3 months. The screw clasp we use for our baby necklaces has been carefully chosen for the safety of young children. In fact, it meets all American, European, and Canadian safety standards for children's jewelry. When there is tension on the necklace, the screw clasp will release and the beads will be held in place on the wire by clamps so that the child cannot access the small pieces. Pure Hazelwood works with accredited laboratories to ensure that Canadian, American, and European safety standards are met.
3. Always ensure that children 3 and under handling any necklace or neck jewelry is **under adult supervision**. Because it is extremely light, most babies won't even notice the necklace and won't be prompted to put it in their mouth.

Finally, here is a simple trick for parents who are afraid to let their little one sleep with their necklace. Just wrap the necklace around the baby's ankle and cover it with a sock or footed pajamas!
